Care instructions

GENTLE CLEANSING

- Pamper with lukewarm hand washing only
- No harsh chemicals - preserve those vibrant hues
- Caress gently, never wring this precious fabric

MINDFUL DRYING

- Air dry away from sunlight to protect colors
- Machine drying is never recommended

REFINED PRESSING

- Use medium heat with a protective cotton barrier
- Press on reverse side while slightly damp
- Handle metallic threads with extra tenderness

LUXURY STORAGE

- Nestle in cool, dry sanctuary
- Fold lovingly with acid-free tissue
- Choose breathable fabric pouches over plastic
- Allow your textile to breathe

PRESERVATION NOTES

- Always test care methods discreetly first
- Consider professional textile specialists for heirloom pieces
- Refold periodically to maintain pristine condition
